For arrival and departure



On arrival

All children should know about certain practical rules. Gather your whole group and give them the following information:

*"Once again, Welcome to Vässarö. We will do everything to make your camp great!"
/staffmembers at Vässarö*

Good things to know

Water from taps **marked red** is fresh water. It is only used for drinking and cooking. Mind the fresh water. Never let the water run on the ground.

Water from taps **marked blue** is sea water (salt). It is used for washing dishes, boiling potatoes and so on. Never wash dishes under running water since it gets muddy very quickly underneath the tap.

Be careful with the black water hoses so that you won't have to carry water from the sea. Inform the camp office (Storgårn "The big house") as soon as you discover any leaks.

During your stay

- Put garbage in the dustbins.
- We sort the garbage according as below:
 - Glass
 - Metal
 - Hard plastic
 - Soft plastic
 - Compost (read more below)
 - Cardboard
- Collect food scraps in a bucket with a lid and empty it in the green containers located by the dustbins or out houses (latrines). Do not fill these containers more than 75%.
- Don't dig holes (except possibly for a flag pole).
- Construction poles can be taken from the piles. If you need more Construction poles, first read "The art of cutting construction wood on Vässarö".
- Fire wood may be found in the fire wood shelters, otherwise you have to gather branches, twigs and so on in the forest.
- Keep the ditches clean.
- Return boxes and cans that you have received from Inten when you pick up new food every day.

Before departure

- Sort the construction poles according to length and pile them so that they don't have direct contact with the ground. At the edge of the forest, not on the field.
- Put all sticks, fire wood and so on in the nearest fire wood shelter. Don't leave fire wood out in the open.
- Put all the iron stoves by the wood piles.
- Put stones from the fire places in a neat pile at the edge of the forest, not on the field (think of the harvester).
- Fill and even out holes after flag poles.
- Clear the ditches from stones, sticks, garbage and clumps of grass.
- Clear the fields from wood chips, shavings and garbage.
- Search the area for garbage, tent nails and lost property.
- Return left over food, cleaned empty crates and so on to the Food Supply



Camp Leaders meetings

Every day at 18:30 1-2 leaders from each group meet at the campfire circle behind Program Office (Lillgårn). There we go through the next day's program and other issues of concern to all groups.
